## FIVE STEPS TO CERTIFICATION

- 1. Applicant completes and submits the application, contract, and annual certification fee. The application fee must be paid to receive the Envirocann Management Plan (EMP) and start the certification process.
- 2. For all scopes, the applicant completes and submits an Envirocann Management Plan (EMP). The EMP is the farm and/or facility plan that details all standard operating practices (SOP) and materials in use.
- 3. A desk audit of the EMP is conducted by Envirocann staff to determine if the site/product(s) can meet certification criteria. If the EMP is accepted, then an annual inspection is scheduled. If the application is incomplete, then the applicant may need to provide more information before an inspection can be scheduled.
- 4. An annual inspection is conducted. An authorized representative of the operation is required to accompany the inspector on the initial visit. The inspector verifies that the EMP accurately reflects the practices in place, including environmental compliance, and social justice. All areas of production will be inspected, along with post-harvest/post processing, storage and processing facilities.
- 5. Certification is granted to clients that meet the certification criteria. If further information or action plans are required to verify compliance, applicants will receive a notification from Envirocann.
